### ACTIVITY REPORT FOR THE MONTH OF APRIL 2016

The new academic session 2016-17 began with a lot of excitement. This was evident by the fresh look on the faces of staff and the students as they spruced up to commence the new session with ardent spirit.

**1. World Health Day:-** The first **Special Assembly** for the academic year on the occasion of World Health Day was held on **7<sup>th</sup> Apr** by students of class VII. A student delivered speech on the importance of the day. They performed a small skit to create health awareness among children. A self composed song consisting of health slogans was sung in the tune of popular Rhyme 'Twinkle Twinkle.....' the thought for the day was 'For good health sake- run, jump and shake.'
