ACTIVITY REPORT FOR THE MONTH OF APRIL 2018

1. Swachh Bharat: - On 7th Apr a rally was conducted in the streets of SVN Colony. Children of class VI, VII, VIII and teachers participated in the rally with placards and slogans. The slogans of swachh Bharat echoed in the streets which were aimed to provide awareness to the residents.

2. Orientation Program(VI-VIII): - An orientation programme was conducted for the parents of classes VI – VIII students in three different sessions on 11th Apr in Samudrika auditorium. The session's aim was to apprise the parents about various changes that have taken place in CBSE. Dr.Parul Kumar, Principal, NCS (VZG) presided over the session, enlightening the parents about the exam and assessment patterns. The session ended with the clarification of several doubts raised by parents.

3. World Health Day: - On 12th Apr a special assembly was conducted by the students of class VI to mark the 'World Health Day'. Children spoke about the importance of the day. Children spoke about the importance of the day and various steps that can be taken in order to keep the Earth green. A scintillating dance performance on mother Earth was performed by the girls. Orientation Program (PRIMARY): - On the same day an orientation program was conducted for class I in community hall, 104 Area and classes II to V in respective classrooms. This was followed by a

presentation by Headmistress, NCS 104 Area Mrs.Srividya, during which the assessment pattern, the school rules etc were explained in detail. Cdr. Manikandan Director NCS (VZG) also spoke to the parents regarding the role of parents in the team work aiming the holistic development of the children.

Guest Lecture: On **21st Apr** a Sujok session was conducted by Mrs. Sneha Maroo. The session was conducted to enlighten the teachers with Sujok therapy. 7. Medhavi Awards: - On **25th Apr** Medhavi Awards were given by the Chief Guest Cdr Manikandan , Director NCS Vizag in the special assembly. The chief guest in his address to the children congratulated the achievers and encouraged the other students to perform well.

8. Orientation Program (KG): - The orientation programme was conducted on **27th Apr** in community hall, 104 Area at 0930 hrs.Headmistress Mrs.Srividya during her presentation explained the points of how parents can help child at home and apprised parents about school rules and exhorted their cooperation. Later parents were requested to move their respective wards classes for special PTI.

Guest Lecture: On the same day a Girl talk session was conducted in the community hall of 104 Area by Ms.Renu Yadav, Graduate and also an alumna of the University of Montana, USA. She also works on USA exchange programme projects with University of Montana on Menstrual Hygiene. The importance of menstrual hygiene was stressed. Menstrual cycle was also explained. It was attended by girl students of class VI-X along with their mothers. This session aimed at apprising both the girls & mothers about the cleanliness, different problems and home remedies which was followed by clarification of myths and doubts raised by girls and mothers.

9. Best Clean Class: Teachers were deputed to check the cleanliness status of each class and to allot marks for maintenance of classroom, blackboard, soft boards etc. based on the judgment class I Q from primary wing and class VII P & Q from Secondary were announced to be the best clean classes.
