KINDERGARTEN ACTIVITY REPORT FEBRUARY 2019

The month of February saw the school come alive with the hustle and bustle of kindergarteners bursting with energy as they went about attending their classes. Various activities were held for the children of the LKG and the UKG this month.

➤ **ROLE PLAY ON “PICNIC AT THE BEACH” BY UKG CHILDREN**

Conversation skill role play was conducted for UKG wing of NSB during morning assembly on 11th February. The topic was “Picnic at the beach”. The aim of conversation role play was to build vocabulary, confidence and inculcate life skills.

➤ **KNOW THE PARTS OF PLANT**

A plant is made up of many different parts. Each part has a set of jobs to do to keep the plant healthy and provide the human genre with things like fruit, vegetable, cotton, medicine, wood etc. On 12th February during morning assembly UKG children were explained about different parts of plant and their respective utilities.
