#### **ACTIVITY REPORT FOR THE MONTH OF APRIL-MAY 2019**

## > OPENING DAY:

The new academic year started on 3<sup>rd</sup> April 19.The day commenced with the teachers decorating the school and their respective classrooms to welcome the tiny tots. Students of LKG and UKG started their first day of school with lots of excitement.Fun filled palm printing activity was conducted for LKG students while UKG students were familiarized with their new classrooms and surroundings. To settle the LKG tots, the timings were initially determined from 0930 hrs to 1100 hrs which were changed 0900 hrs to 1230 hrs after 03 weeks.

#### > INTRODUCTION OF RED COLOUR:

Red colour was introduced to LKG children during morning special assembly on 5<sup>th</sup>April.The LKG assembly area was decorated with red colour theme and teachers were also dressed in red. Rhyme related to red colour was sung to emphasize the colour concept.

#### > WORLD HEALTH DAY:

World Health Day was celebrated for both LKG and UKG children during the assembly on 8<sup>th</sup>April. The children were informed and motivated to eat healthy food, drink plenty of water, exercise daily and maintain good hygiene. Cutouts of fruits and vegetablescoloured by children were pinned to their dresses to give emphasis on *Eat healthy and Stay healthy*.

## > GROUP ACTIVITY - PAPER TEARING AND PASTING (LKG):

Paper Tearing and Pasting activity was conducted on 9<sup>th</sup>April for LKG classes. It was a structured activity in which children were made to paste the torn paper inside an apple made on a chart paper.

## > GROUP ACTIVITY - PAPER CRUMBLING AND PASTING (UKG):

Paper crumbling and Pasting activity was conducted on 9<sup>th</sup>April for UKG classes to improve their fine motor skills and coordination. Children enjoyed tearing, crumpling and pasting small pieces of paper in a mango made on chart.

#### > INTRODUCTION OF YELLOW COLOUR:

Yellow colour was introduced on 10<sup>th</sup> April to LKG children during the morning assembly. The LKG assembly area was decorated with yellow colour theme and

teachers were also dressed in yellow. Rhyme related to yellow colour was sung to emphasize the colour concept.

## > GROUP ACTIVITY - PAPER CRUSHING AND PASTING (LKG):

Paper crushing and Pasting activity was conducted on 12<sup>th</sup>April for LKG classes to develop their fine motor skills and coordination. Children enjoyed tearing, crushing and pasting small pieces of paper in a corn cob made on chart.

## > WALK AROUND THE SCHOOL (UKG):

Walk around the school was conducted for UKG classes on 12<sup>th</sup>April to familiarize the children with the school premises. Children enjoyed exploring different areas of the school like traffic park, library, activity room, pantry and office.

## > INTRODUCTION OF BLUE COLOUR:

Blue colour was introduced on 15<sup>th</sup>April to LKG children during the morning assembly. The LKG assembly area was decorated with blue colour theme and teachers were also dressed in blue. Rhyme related to blue colour was sung to emphasize the colour concept.

### RAINBOW WRITING ACTIVITY (UKG):

Rainbow writing activity was conducted for UKG children. This colourful activity reinforced the colour concept, development of fine motor skills, and eye-hand coordination in children.

#### WORLD HERITAGE DAY:

World Heritage Day was celebrated on 17<sup>th</sup> April during the morning assembly for LKG and UKG classes with an aim to promote awareness among children about diversity of our cultural heritage and to sensitize them to protect our invaluable assets such as historical monuments and buildings. Children were shown a few models of important monuments with their brief history and significance.

## > VEGETABLE PRINTING ACTIVITY (UKG):

To enhance creativity among children, a vegetable printing activity was conducted on 17<sup>th</sup>April for UKG classes. Children enjoyed making and converting vegetable prints in to beautiful flowers with the help of their respective class teachers.

#### > ORIENTATION PROGRAMME:

Orientation Programme and Special PTI was conducted on 19<sup>th</sup>April for parents towards awareness about their wards, school environment, its functioning, rules and regulations. The points highlighted were aims, goals, activities, academics and various other aspects of the school and the KG Programme. A special PTI was

conducted towards end of the Orientation to answer parent's queries and seek their suggestions to make the learning experience of their child a unique one.

## **WORKSHOP FOR TEACHERS:**

A workshop on 'Occupational Therapy and Role of Occupational Therapist at School' was conducted for teachers on 20<sup>th</sup>April by Dr. Anupama. Workshop provided clear insight on the role of occupational therapist at school and different teaching methods followed by them to teach children, with different types of learning problems.

#### **WORLD EARTH DAY:**

World earth day was celebrated for LKG and UKG classes during the morning assembly on 22<sup>nd</sup>April with an aim to sensitize them to become campaigners for environmental conservation. Children were explained the importance of trees, use of cloth bags or jute bags instead of plastic bags, harmful effects of pollution and tips to control different types of pollutions with the help of charts, models and placards. Children also learnt the importance of *reduce, reuse and recycle*. As part of earth day celebrations, plantation activity was conducted, and each class planted a sapling and pledged to plant more trees to make our earth better place to live.

## GROUP ACTIVITY - COLLAGE OF SHAPES (UKG):

A group activity of making Collage of Shapes and Colours was conducted on 23<sup>th</sup> April for UKG children. This activity reinforced the concept of colours and shapes in a creative way. Children enjoyed sticking the cut out of shapes of various colours on a chart paper.

As a part of conversational skill development activity, arole play was conducted for UKG students during morning assembly on 25<sup>th</sup> April. The topic was "Getting ready to school". Children learnt sentence formation and new words associated with the topic.

## > VEGETABLE PRINTING ACTIVITY (LKG):

A group activity of vegetable printing was conducted on 26<sup>th</sup>April for LKG children. Vegetable printing activity wasaimed to enhance fine motor skills and creativity among children. Children enjoyed making vegetable prints on ice cream made on chart.
